From the Desk of Ross O'Banion, Executive Director

While at this time of the year most of the world is contemplating what Santa is going to bring them for Christmas, for the Providers of services licensed by Agency for People with Disabilities, we are wondering what the Legislature will do to us this year after Christmas. This year we need to make a concerted effort to communicate effectively the message of what we must have in Florida to continue to provide services to the very vulnerable population. We have endured years of cuts in rates, cuts in services, increases in regulation and increasing operating costs. The net effect is that many of the providers are financially in very bad positions. Florida must take immediate steps to end this decade of cuts to this vital area of our state budget.

A Word From Ross

ARC of Florida's suggestion is: Florida must increase provider rates by 5% for the 2014-2015 fiscal year and the funding for this should not be taken away from current client services. The ARC of Florida also supports building a plan to continue to increase rates in the coming years and increasing all provider rates to at least the minimum wage.

Florida must invest in provider rate increases so individuals with Intellectual Disabilities are served by qualified and quality professionals. Right now, professionals working with Floridians with Intellectual Disabilities make less money than employee's at a fast food restaurant, although they are responsible for people's lives and are required to have and maintain a much higher level of training. Payments for Floridians with Intellectual Disabilities in residential setting currently range from as low as \$3.01 per hour for basic care to \$11.04 per hour to care for the most involved individuals. If minimum wage is increased any further without increasing the APD rates a crisis of staff leaving this field of care for more lucrative pay will emerge quickly.

<u>Please contact the legislative delegation now and start pushing them</u> <u>in this area.</u> Something must be done now, this problem is not going away, and will get worse the longer it is not dealt with. Daily we are losing qualified, quality, caring staff due to the simple fact they can no longer pay their bills and feed their families on the horrible wages providers are able to pay. Most staff have not had a wage increase in over 8 years and some have had wage reductions along the way to balance budgets.
