#### From the Desk of Ross O'Banion, Executive Director

As most of you are aware, it is the time of year that our State Legislature and the National Legislature is back in session. This means we all have twice as much to follow, influence, and voice our opinion on the various issues at hand. As citizens and Americans it is our duty and responsibility to hold our representatives accountable for their actions that they should be taking on our behalf. In order to do this it is incumbent upon us to know the issues and to voice our opinions.

Please allow me to encourage you to do this at this time of the year. Below are the issues that are important to Angels Unaware, Inc. please take the time to contact your State Legislature and make them also aware of your support. Call them, write them, and visit them at home to make sure they understand the importance of what we do, and why we do it.

A.R.C. of Florida - 2015 Legislative Priorities, Angels Unaware, Inc. supports the entire list, however has chosen to focus on the following two as the most critical. For the complete list please go to their <u>website</u>.

#### **ISSUE #1 – PROVIDER RATE REINSTATEMENT**

In 2003, the Florida Legislature mandated a provider rate study for the Agency for Persons with Disabilities, APD. This is the only validated study that had ever been conducted on APD provider rates by the Legislature. Since 2003, providers have seen their rates decreased over 14%. This decrease has occurred in a 10 year period where minimum wage increased over 54%. Today the state minimum wage is \$7.92 (2014) and now has increased to \$8.05 (2015) but provider rates begin at \$6.72 per hour. In the past 10 years health care, worker's compensation, and property insurance rates, have skyrocketed and inflation has increased over 32%.

Solution: Return Provider Rates to the 2003 Level over a 2-Year Period. Increase provider rates by 7% this session and again next year (2016). An investment this year of \$23 million to \$26 million in general revenue funds would allow providers to remain in business and pay minimum wage and over.

Companies and the U.S. Military considering Florida locations for installations desire communities where employees can have their family needs met. Offering community based services is an additional enticement for bringing jobs to Florida. Reinstatement of the rates is essential in order to continue Developmental Disabilities Home and Community based waiver services.

#### **ISSUE #2 – FUND THE WAITNING LIST FOR SERVICES**

Some families have been waiting over 12 years for waiver services.

The Legislature and the Governor have worked to fund some of the most crucial needs; however there are still more than <u>18,000 families</u> without services and many more with reduced services. There are providers with open service positions (group homes with vacant beds, Day Programs with daily vacancies etc.) that could help provide needed services to the citizens and families on the waiting list if the waiting list was fully funded.
