Mr. Richard Evans (1906-1971), a clergyman and radio personality said, "We can't do everything for everyone everywhere, but we can do something for someone somewhere." In the past few months there has never before been a need for each of us to follow Mr. Evan's charge. First in our world and now in our own country, never before have we seen such destruction and desperation in areas so close to our homes, knowing full well that "it could have been here".

Mr. Dozier with ARC of the Greater New Orleans area has 25 individuals that were in supported living that are now homeless—and these were the lucky ones! He also has to provide burials for those that were not so lucky. Ms. Diane Baham of the Tammany ARC of Sidell Louisiana lost a 14,000 sq. ft. workshop and had to lay off 337 out of 355 employees. She also lost a group home and all their vehicles. She cried when she heard that Florida organizations were wanting to help. Organizations in Mississippi and Alabama are suffering the same daily challenges. Our experience with the storm in Punta Gorda have taught us it will take years to heal from the physical effects of a large storm.

While I can not explain why bad things happen to good people, I can encourage you to follow Mr. Evan's charge and do something for someone, somewhere. Many of you support Angels Unaware, Inc. on a regular basis, and now our nation needs you to continue that support and at the same time help others. That is not easy with rising costs that each of us face, but consider what your life would be like today if it was your turn. YOUR TURN??? Remember, the reason our nation is the greatest on Earth—"Some gave all, all gave some." God bless you and God bless America.

Scholarship Fund

Some may not know that Angels Unaware, Inc. has what we affectionately call "Scholarship Fund". Some of our consumers have no family due to death, or may have family who no longer stays in contact. Due to the continuous cuts in funding by the State of Florida, our consumers are forced to bear more and more financial burdens. Angels Unaware developed this fund to help these consumers with little or no funds and those who do not have family to go home with for the holidays. We make sure they have Christmas, birthdays, presents, trees, and holiday dinners just like everyone else in America. The Scholarship fund, along with community organizations and individuals, helps to make this happen.

For an example, we once had a consumer receive a much needed new wheelchair that did not include the lap tray (\$650). This presented a real problem as this person eats, works, transports, and sits in this specially designed wheelchair most of the day. This tray was a vital component of the chair. This consumer had to cover the cost due to the Medicare/Medicaid limitations and his personal funds weren't enough. When consumers take vacations each year, or attend some community event, some do not have the funds to go. The Scholarship fund helps those in need to participate.
