

So many of the local sports franchises have been good to our guys. The Lightning has given us some tickets, or at the very least, we've never paid full price for a ticket. The Tampa Yankees always sends some tickets our way. The Tampa Bay Buccaneers have even invited some of the guys to join them on the practice field during preseason.





We just finished up with the restaurant raffle, Tropical Storm Fay caused us to cancel the August Board Meeting where we intended to conduct the drawing. That drawing was rescheduled to September 9th and by the time you read this it will have been held and the winners announced. I am sorry we delayed the drawing for what must now seem like a minor issue, but let me help you understand.

In Hillsborough County there are no shelters that are set-up for or designated for our residents. As time goes on we hope to have a facility that is hardened to survive a hurricane so that we can be more confident of our ability to fulfill our obligations to our residents in the event of a hurricane. So please continue to support our fund raising activities and speak to our Government about planning for <u>all</u> of our citizens. Maybe someday a tropical storm or hurricane will only be a minor inconvenience to the Angel's staff and not a cause for major upheaval.
